


Steroids Abuse Chart– BA064

Long periods of excessive back strains, muscle tearing. ANKLE: The top of the ankle is bowed leg. DRUGS & PERSONALITY: Excessive steroid use can lead to personality changes. Excessive mood swings, aggression, all other feelings, rage, depression, irritability, and anger. TESTES: Decreased size and number of sperm. Leads to low sperm count and low libido. TESTICULAR: Testes shrink. VOICE: Hoarseness and deepening of the voice in males. HEART: Increased risk of heart disease. Heart attack, stroke, and death. High blood pressure. Increased cholesterol. Increased risk of heart disease. STOMACH: Swelling of stomach. Indigestion, nausea, vomiting, and constipation of stool. KIDNEYS: Kidney failure. Kidney stones. GLANDS: Prostate enlargement. REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> MALES: Reduced sperm count. Testes shrink. Impotence, decreased libido, and decreased testosterone. FEMALES: Changes in menstrual periods, infertility, closed uterine cervix, and breast. JOINTS AND FEET: Blood poisoning from bacteria. High risk of infection. Swelling. Pain in the joints.
