◆ This chart provides information about which muscles are supplied by major nerves to the posterior aspect of the upper limb. It illustrates the nerves which make up the cervical and brachial plexus as well as showing the major nerves that supply the scapula, back of arm and hand. Important educational information is provided about the nerves and which muscles they innervate. The main diagram names the major nerves and confirms the muscles they supply. As with the other charts in the set it provides an excellent visual reference from which to learn.
